Dear Parents/Carers,

Consultation - Proposed Significant Change 'Closure of Sixth Form' from September 2025

The sixth form at Holderness Academy has prepared students for higher education, employment and training with many of our students going on to study at university and has been an important part of the school to date.

Over the last few years, falling numbers in the Sixth Form have meant that it may no longer be viable to run. It is deeply disappointing that we are writing to formally notify you of the decision to commence a consultation period with regard to a proposed 'Significant Change' to close the Sixth Form provision within our school from September 2025.

This consultation period is for a period of 4 weeks from the date of this letter and no decision will be reached until the consultation has concluded. The consultation will take place with our stakeholders and affected employees. All responses received during the consultation will be seriously considered before a final decision is taken to send a business case for closure to the Department for Education.

If the proposed closure is confirmed, following consultation, there will be no reduction to the sixth form this academic year and we will ensure that our current students continue to receive high quality provision and support. Our students in years 10 and 11 will continue to receive high quality careers advice and guidance, ensuring that all students are supported during their transition to post-16 education and/or training, including visits to other sixth forms and further education providers.

The rationale for the proposed closure which will be discussed during consultation is as follows:

- There are several other sixth forms and further education providers within the City of Hull and County of East Riding of Yorkshire, providing excellent opportunities for high quality educational experiences for post-16 students.
- The majority of our Year 11 students are not opting to stay at the Sixth Form. There are currently 26 students in Year 13 and no students in Year 12.
- In view of the diminishing numbers, the projected costs of continuing with a sixth form will have a negative financial impact on educational provision for all of our students.
- We need to ensure that resources, including finances, leadership, management and educational expertise, are allocated effectively to improve educational standards and outcomes for the majority of students at the school.

Our decision to begin consultation in respect of our sixth form provision at Holderness is not one that has been taken lightly and follows a comprehensive review by the Trust.
